The California FAIR Plan Association was established to meet the needs of California homeowners unable to find insurance in the traditional marketplace. For most of these homeowners, the FAIR Plan is a temporary safety net intended to support them until coverage offered by a traditional carrier becomes available. Two years ago, they had 50 employees. Today, they have almost 200.



CHALLENGE

The proliferation of wildfires in the state combined with the needs of the pandemic caused rapid growth for the FAIR Plan, especially the IT team. They increased staff from three to four to 10 in an attempt to keep up with the company's needs as new employees were hired to work remotely.

The initial setup for endpoints was costing them time and money because they were being configured manually, one by one. "It was time-consuming and a major hassle," said Pablo Gallegos, System Administrator. "We'd have to schedule meetings with new employees, kick them off their computers for a time, get them back on, and make sure their computers deployed correctly."
